


We're pantomiming now.

Preparation: Make one copy of this list for every 8-10 students.

1. You are carrying 100 eggs. An earthquake starts. 
2. You are swimming. You see a shark.
3. You are camping in the country. You see a ghost.
4. You are cooking 100 kilograms of spaghetti.
5. You are climbing a mountain in January.
6. You are swimming in a dirty river.
7. There is a storm. The lights go out. You are trying to find a flashlight.
8. You are selling something at a festival. (What are you selling?)
9. You are cleaning windows of a very tall building. You are on the outside.
10. You are riding your bicycle. It is raining.

Photocopiable - *Firsthand ACCESS*

Procedure:

1. Students work in groups of 8-10. They tear apart the sentences on the list. Without looking, each person chooses one.

2. Students take turns pantomiming the situation. Partners guess.

Note: You may want to have learners do the pantomime in pairs. This can add to their confidence and make it more fun.
