

Unit 8

Alphabet food

Preparation: None

Procedure:

You'll buy some Apples.

I'll buy some Bananas.

1. Students work in pairs. On a piece of paper, students write the alphabet, A-Z. On paper per pair.
2. Tell them to imagine they are going on an "Alphabet picnic". They have to bring one thing for every letter of the alphabet (except "x"). Students take turns. They must repeat their partner's sentence, then add their own. They cross out the letters they use.

Variation: For more of a challenge, have them say the items in A-B-C order.

As they work, circulate. When pairs are having difficulty, give them a hint. Here are some answers for difficult letters:

K: = knife, kiwi, KFC Q= quiche, the queen (we didn't say they could only bring food). U= Umbrella (we didn't say they could only bring food).

Y = yoghurt, yellow bananas Z = zucchini, zebra meat
