

## **Unit 2**

### **Memory test**

**Preparation:** none

**Procedure:**

1. Students work in pairs. They look at the people in the picture on page 21 for exactly one minute.
2. They close their books. In pairs, they write as many sentences describing the clothing as they can in four minutes. The pair with the most correct sentences is the winner.

### **Fashion show**

Note: Unlike the other optional activities on this list, this one takes quite a bit of time. One or two class periods should be allowed. It is, for most classes, a highly rewarding and motivating activity. Preparation: none Procedure:

1. Tell the students they will put on a fashion show. Students work in pairs. First, they decide what they will wear in the fashion show. Each student describes the clothing to a partner who draws a picture of the clothing. The partners then write descriptions. (The descriptions should be similar to those they heard in the listening activity on page 21.)
2. After the first partner checks the description for content, the other student practices reading the description aloud.
3. They bring or wear the clothes during the next class period. Divide the class in half. Each half puts on a fashion show for the other half (or invite another class to watch). Note: If your students are required to wear uniforms, it may be necessary to get permission for them to wear other clothing in school.
