Paper airplane past

Preparation: Each student will need 4 sheets of paper. This activity assume

Procedure:

1. Students look through their book, especially unit 7 and find four verbs. They write one verb in large letters on each piece of paper. They should write the very in the present tense.
2. Then they fold each paper into a simple paper airplane.
3. Everyone stands up. They work in pairs. They throw their airplane to someone on the other side of the room. With their partner, they pickup airplanes thrown by other students. They open the plane and see the verb. The students work together to say a story including the verb. I must include at least 4 past tense sentences. Then they continue to collect more airplanes.

Note: If you want to do this as a competitive game, they keep the airplanes. Each one counts as a point for that pair. If you want it to be a more chaotic, free-form activity, they refold the planes and throw them again.
